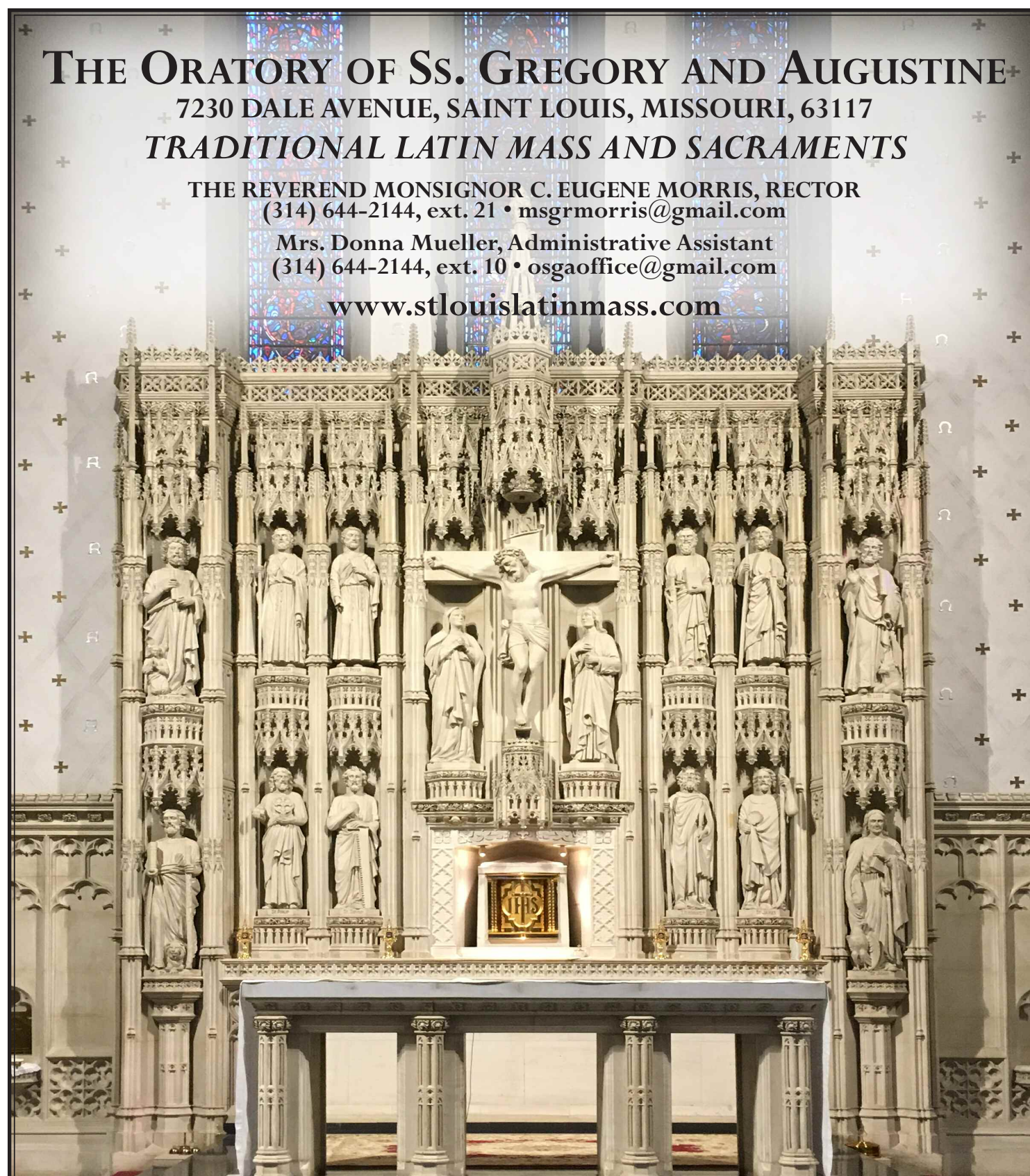

FROM THE RECTOR

Time and space will not allow me to do adequate justice to the great Solemnity of Pentecost. After the celebration of Easter, this great feast ranks second marked liturgically by a solemn vigil celebration as well as the privileged Octave of Pentecost. These liturgical dynamics express the desire of Holy Mother Church that we Her faithful sons and daughters should spend these days leading to the Solemnity of Pentecost and the eight days immediately following meditating on the great mystery that is revealed to us with the descent of the Holy Spirit. Our Savior has told us that He would send the Advocate to continue to teach, instruct and admonish us. With the gift of the Holy Spirit, the work of salvation which was always intended for all mankind can now spread to the ends of the earth. The Lord commissioned the apostles to teach, baptize and remain steadfast and now with the reception of the Holy Spirit their cooperation with the grace of God will bear fruit that will last. We are the inheritors of their openness to the Holy Spirit. Consequently, we must receive the Holy Spirit with the same humble hearts as the apostles did and allow ourselves to be instruments of Christ's redemptive work for salvation of the world. Let's pray more fervently this coming week: *Come Holy Spirit and fill the hearts of your faithful!*
