FROM THE RECTOR

Today, the Church celebrates the Dedication of the St. Michael the Archangel and the consecration of this Church in his honor by Boniface II in 530 AD. Our Gospel for today exhorts us to the virtue of humility reminding us that the greatest in the Kingdom of God are the little children who with profound trust have confidence in the works of our Heavenly Father. It is only through a deliberate practice of humility that we have any hope of becoming pliable in the hands of God. Moreover, as the Gospel continues the Lord enjoins us to a severity in our endeavoring to avoid and overcome sin such that we are better off cutting off limbs and plucking out our eyes instead of falling into sin. This applies not only to mortal sins which are to be avoided assiduously, but also to venial sins which weaken us in the practice of virtue and growth in holiness. By baptism, we are God's sons and daughters. Let us strive through the graces of Holy Mass to remain always His children, firmly rooted in humility, constantly striving for holiness, always diligent in the avoidance of sin.

MISSALS ARE IN THE PEWS

You will notice this weekend that the new St. Edmund Campion Missals are now in the pews for use during the celebration of Holy Mass and the other sacred mysteries. Again, thank you to all the donors who made this a successful project for the Oratory. I am truly grateful for your generosity. Having this Missal in the pews will not only assist those already familiar with the traditional Latin Mass, but also greatly assist those who are new to the Oratory and are still growing in their understanding and familiarity with the Holy Mass. <u>A few practical notes</u>: In the front cover of the book is the Prayer to Our Lady of Walsingham that is prayed by our community after the 11:30 am High Mass on Sundays. In the back of the Missal are the Marian Antiphons that are chanted after High Mass on Sunday. You will also notice that a number appears underneath the heading of each antiphon which refers to the corresponding musical notations in the hymnal section of the Missal. Finally, please take a moment to familiarize yourself with the Missal. I am so grateful for this clear manifestation of our stability and growth as a community of faith.
