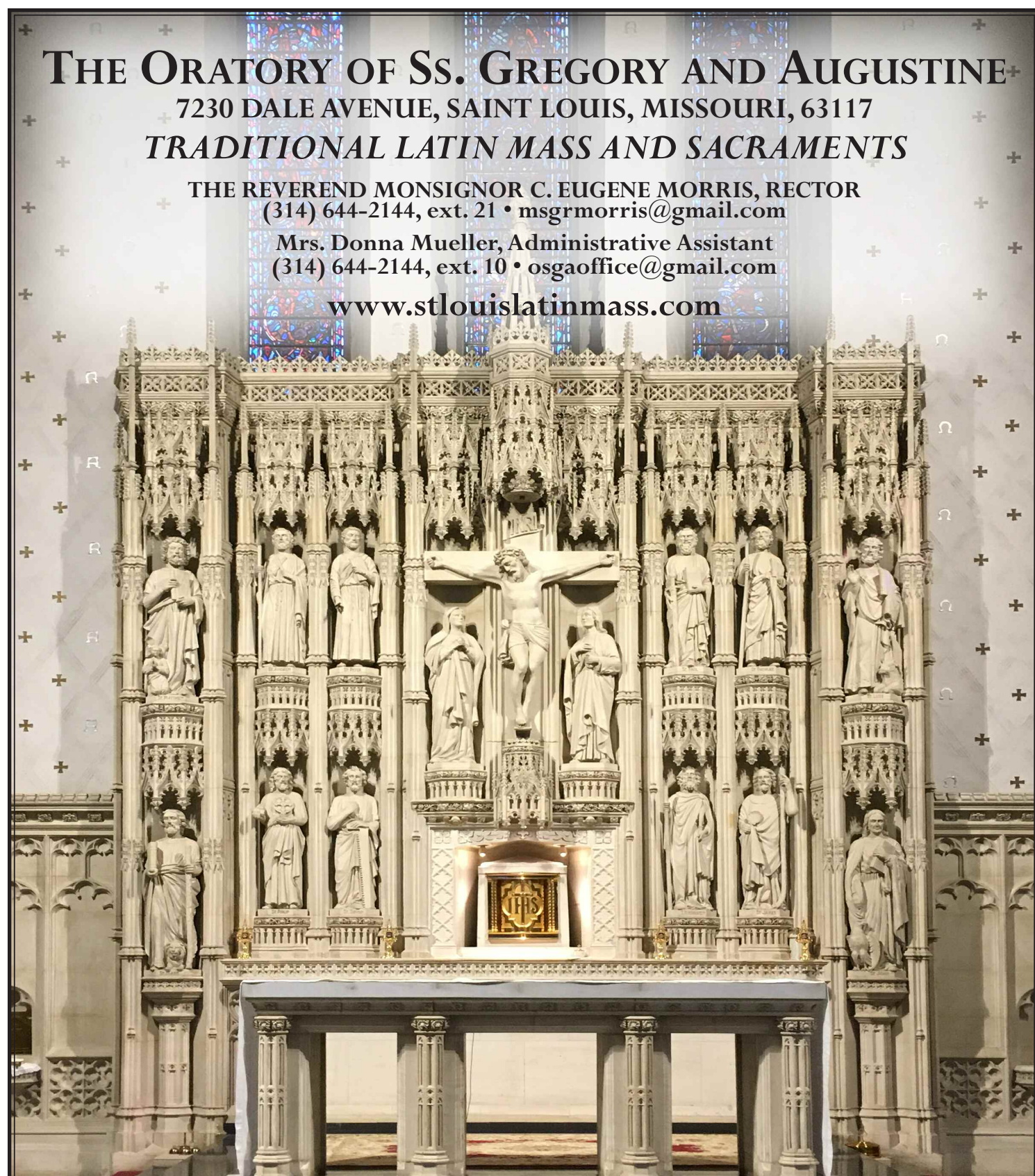

FROM THE RECTOR

The External Celebration of the Most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary provides an opportunity to contemplate the reality and mystery of God through the eyes of Our Blessed Mother. This celebration was instituted primarily to commemorate the battle of Lepanto on October 7th, 1571 when Christian forces through the intercession of Our Blessed Lady broke the forces of Islam which threatened to overwhelm Europe. The feast was extended to the whole Church by Clement XI and Leo XIII raised the rank of the feast and provided a new Mass and Office seeking Our Lady’s intercession for the Church in the modern age. It is clear that the Church and the world still need the special and unique mediation of the Blessed Mother and the most concrete way for us to attain Her special favors is praying the Holy Rosary on a daily basis. We honor Our Lady because She is the Mother of God, Queen of Heaven and Earth and our Divine Mother. Her humility and complete trust in the will of our Heavenly Father is the exemplar for all who follow Her Son. Moreover, throughout the Church’s history, Her apparitions and interventions are concrete expressions of Her powerful mediation and the desire She has to care for all Her children. You will notice this weekend that the new St. Edmund Campion Missals are now in the pews for use during the celebration of Holy Mass and the other sacred mysteries. You will also notice that a number appears underneath the heading of each antiphon which refers to the corresponding musical notations in the hymnal section of the Missal. Finally, please take a moment to familiarize yourself with the Missal. I am so grateful for this clear manifestation of our stability and growth as a community of faith.
