FROM THE RECTOR

We are all called to strive for holiness in our daily lives; to seek to become Saints! The recent canonization of St. John Henry Cardinal Newman and several others reminds us that cooperation with God's grace is indeed possible if we strive mightily to conform ourselves to His will. So too, St. John Newman reminds us of the need for sacrifice and a joyful embrace of the Cross of Our Savior.
