Today we celebrate Septuagesima Sunday and benefit from the wisdom of Holy Mother Church as She assists us preparing ourselves for our Lenten Retreat. How blessed we are to have these weeks to prepare ourselves for the journey of Lent which requires spiritual strength and constancy. One does not prepare for a marathon the day before it begins. So it is with the Lenten season. Our preparation needs to begin now in order to be well prepared for Ash Wednesday. During the several weeks use your time in prepare to ask the Lord what sacrifices you should make, how your prayer life should increase and what generosity are you able to make manifest. Be practical and concrete in order to find success in your sacrifices before God. Seek first the kingdom of God and all good things shall come to you!

SEASON OF SEPTUAGESIMA AND LENT

The season of Septuagesima begins today and provides us with the opportunity to better prepare ourselves for our Lenten Season which begins on Wednesday, 26 February 2020. In order to spiritually assist the faithful of the Oratory during the Lenten season there will be additional opportunities for confession.

During Lent, in addition to the times already published, confessions will be heard before the 7 am Masses on Tuesday and Thursday, beginning at 6 am. <u>These confession times will begin on Thursday, 12 March 2020.</u>

We will also have the morning of Confessions on Saturday, 14 March 2020 from 8:00 am until 11:00 am.

Stations of Cross will be celebrated each Friday of Lent at 7 pm. On the two First Fridays of Lent (5 March and 4 April) Stations will begin after the conclusion of Holy Mass.

Finally, the schedule for Holy Week has been determined and again will have the opportunity to celebrate each day of the Sacred Triduum. This information is shared early so that you might plan your schedules accordingly: HOLY THURSDAY @ 5:00 PM; GOOD FRIDAY @ 3PM; HOLY SATURDAY @ 4:30 PM.

All of this information will continue to be available both in the bulletin and on-line. Also, next Sunday there will be a sheet on the Oratory table in the vestibule that will have all this information for our Lenten season.

FOSTERING EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

I have been approached about the possibility of having Eucharistic Adoration at the Oratory. I am very excited about the possibilities that exist before us. As the community has continued to grow, we are now able (I believe) to move forward with increasing our devotional life. There are at least two possibilities before us. Option #1: A Holy Hour after the 11:30 am Mass on the First Sunday of the month. Option #2: Extended Eucharistic Adoration from the conclusion of Holy Mass on First Friday until to the evening Mass on First Friday. Option #2 provides a longer period of time for Adoration which I think would be spiritually profitable for the whole community.

In order for Option #2 to be viable there needs to be enough interest from the faithful to make sure that at least two people are present with Our Eucharistic Lord every half hour during the period of adoration.

In the coming weeks, a survey will be made available to the community to see in which direction we will be able to move. As you wait for the survey please prayerfully consider what time you might be able to make available to be with Our Eucharistic Lord.
