FROM THE RECTOR - Sexagesima

During the season of Septuagesima, the Church sets before us for contemplation Adam, Noah and Abraham, Old Testament figures who are intimately involved in salvation history. Noah's fidelity to the Lord and obedience to the will of the Father along with his constancy during the flood are a foreshadowing of the coming of the salvific work of Christ and the response that we should have to Our Savior and what He accomplishes for us. Like Noah we are called to fidelity and obedience; so too, fidelity and obedience are fruits of the cleansing waters of baptism that Christ provides for His chosen ones. If the ark saved the world at one time, the wood of the cross has saved the whole world for all time. As we continue to prepare for Lent and strive to root out sin and grow in holiness, let us give particular attention to fidelity and obedience as necessary virtues in our spiritual growth. Let us listen attentively to St. Paul's exhortation to the Corinthians and find our strength in suffering and glorify the Lord through our sacrifices.

SEASON OF SEPTUAGESIMA AND LENT

During Lent, in addition to the times already published, confessions will be heard before the 7 am Masses on Tuesday and Thursday, beginning at 6 am. These confession times will begin on Thursday, 12 March 2020.

We will also have the morning of Confessions on Saturday, 14 March $2020~\mathrm{from}~8:00~\mathrm{am}$ until $11:00~\mathrm{am}$.

Stations of Cross will be celebrated each Friday of Lent at 7 pm. On the two First Fridays of Lent (5 March and 4 April) Stations will begin after the conclusion of Holy Mass.

Finally, the schedule for Holy Week has been determined and again will have the opportunity to celebrate each day of the Sacred Triduum. This information is shared early so that you might plan your schedules accordingly: HOLY THURSDAY @ 5:00 PM; GOOD FRIDAY @ 3PM; HOLY SATURDAY @ 4:30 PM.

All of this information will continue to be available both in the bulletin and online and sheets are available on the Oratory table in the vestibule that have all this information for our Lenten season.

FOSTERING EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

I have been approached about the possibility of having Eucharistic Adoration at the Oratory. I am very excited about the possibilities that exist before us. As the community has continued to grow, we are now able (I believe) to move forward with increasing our devotional life. There are at least two possibilities before us. Option #1: A Holy Hour after the 11:30 am Mass on the First Sunday of the month. Option #2: Extended Eucharistic Adoration from the conclusion of Holy Mass on First Friday until to the evening Mass on First Friday. Option #2 provides a longer period of time for Adoration which I think would be spiritually profitable for the whole community.

In order for Option #2 to be viable there needs to be enough interest from the faithful to make sure that at least two people are present with Our Eucharistic Lord every half hour during the period of adoration.

In the coming weeks, a survey will be made available to the community to see in which direction we will be able to move. As you wait for the survey please prayerfully consider what time you might be able to make available to be with Our Eucharistic Lord.
