First Sunday of Lent March 1, 2020

FROM THE RECTOR – First Sunday of Lent

And so it begins. The Church in Her wisdom provides us the opportunity to contemplate the love of Christ and the mystery of His Cross during the Lenten season. Through intense prayer, fasting and almsgiving each of us can more completely configure ourselves to the mystery of the Lord's cross. The work of salvation belongs completely to Christ who invites us to cooperate in His work through our human efforts. As such we should be serious about our Lenten disciplines, not easily excusing ourselves from them and take advantage of the sacrament of penance as often as needed. There are a great many temptations that plague us and make it even more difficult for us to subject ourselves to the will of God. Overcoming temptation and sin requires radical and complete trust in the grace of Christ. As we journey with Our Lord to the Cross, let us use wisely these days set before us that we might overcome our own weaknesses and find our strength in God alone!

SEASON OF LENT

During Lent, in addition to the times already published, confessions will be heard before the 7 am Masses on Tuesday and Thursday, beginning at 6 am. <u>These confession times will begin on Thursday, 12 March 2020</u>.

We will also have the morning of Confessions on Saturday, 14 March 2020 from 8:00 am until 11:00 am.

Stations of Cross will be celebrated each Friday of Lent at 7 pm. On the two First Fridays of Lent (6 March and 3 April) Stations will begin after the conclusion of Holy Mass.

Finally, the schedule for Holy Week has been determined and again will have the opportunity to celebrate each day of the Sacred Triduum. This information is shared early so that you might plan your schedules accordingly: HOLY THURSDAY @ 5:00 PM; GOOD FRIDAY @ 3PM; HOLY SATURDAY @ 4:30 PM.

FOSTERING EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

I have been approached about the possibility of having Eucharistic Adoration at the Oratory. I am very excited about the possibilities that exist before us. As the community has continued to grow, we are now able (I believe) to move forward with increasing our devotional life. There are at least two possibilities before us. Option #1: A Holy Hour after the 11:30 am Mass on the First Sunday of the month. Option #2: Extended Eucharistic Adoration from the conclusion of Holy Mass on First Friday until to the evening Mass on First Friday. Option #2 provides a longer period of time for Adoration which I think would be spiritually profitable for the whole community.

In order for Option #2 to be viable there needs to be enough interest from the faithful to make sure that at least two people are present with Our Eucharistic Lord every half hour during the period of adoration.

In the coming weeks, a survey will be made available to the community to see in which direction we will be able to move. As you wait for the survey please prayerfully consider what time you might be able to make available to be with Our Eucharistic Lord.
