FROM THE RECTOR – Pentecost Sunday

The coming of the Holy Spirit completes the celebration of the glories of the Resurrection and turns us toward the daily living of the Christian life. The Lord ascends to His throne in Heaven in order to send us the Advocate who continues the work of Christ. With the coming of the Holy Spirit we are now clearly drawn into relationship with the Holy Trinity who is revealed to us in all glory and majesty. With the Feast of Pentecost the apostles are armed with strength in order to fulfill the command given to them by Our Lord at His Ascension: Go into the world and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. It is now possible for them to do precisely that for the Holy Spirit enliven and emboldens in the success of their apostolic work. It is the Holy Spirit who speaks to the prophets, who overshadows Our Lady and makes Her the mother of God. It is the Spirit who leads the Lord into the desert and is present at His baptism. It is the Spirit who inspires the writers of Sacred Scripture and guarantees the infallibility of the Church through Her bishops and priests. What is clear, then, is the need to become pliable in the hands of the Holy Spirit. All those who have gone before us clearly understood the need to find their confidence and trust in the Spirit and let themselves be led wherever God desires. Moreover, than ever the Church needs to find Her confidence in strength in the Holy Spirit by remaining faithful and obedient to the commands of God. For our part, through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, let us strive to be men and women of fervent prayer through which we become like Her easily moved by the promptings of the Spirit!

ADDITIONAL HOLY MASS:

In order to provide everyone an opportunity to be present at Holy Mass on Sunday there will be an additional Holy Mass at 6:45 am. The 8:00 am and the 11:30 will continue as normal. At the 6:45 am and 8:00 am Low Masses there will no homily given. The 11:30 am High Mass a brief homily will be given. At this juncture, I am asking the faithful to consider being present for the 6:45 am Low Mass so that we will be able to keep social distancing, and all be present for Holy Mass. Also, at this time there will be no sign-up sheet for Mass. However, if we arrive at the situation where there are more people at 8:00 am or 11:30 am it could necessitate people signingup prior to Sunday Mass and once a Mass time is filled with the allotted number of parishioners you would have the opportunity for a second or third choice. Again, at this time I am relying upon the faithful to spread themselves out over the three (3) Holy Masses available.

OCTAVE OF PENTECOST

We will celebrate the Octave of Pentecost with Sung Masses each evening in addition to our normal Mass schedule. Beginning tomorrow, 1 June 2020, evening Sung Masses will be at 7:00 pm with confessions at 6:00 pm. The exception is Wednesday evening which will follow our normal schedule of Mass and confessions. On Saturday morning, 6 June Holy Mass will be celebrated at 8:00am with confessions beginning at 7:00 am. The increase in Sung Masses is to provide us an opportunity to celebrate with greater dignity and solemnity the many great feasts on the Church's calendar. Again, please make every effort to attend and encourage others to be present as well.

ONGOING CHURCH CLEANING

So too, we are encouraged to wipe down the pews, doors and public areas after each Mass. The sealant/disinfectant that is being applied to all surfaces in church by Woodward stays active on all surfaces for two weeks; they recommend using a dry cloth to wipe down all surfaces after each Mass.
