FROM THE RECTOR – Tenth Sunday after Pentecost

In his exhortation to the Corinthians, Saint Paul reflects on the reality of the Holy Spirit who allows us to speak the Holy Name and to serve Him through a diversity of gifts. Authentic and true diversity recognizes that all our gifts and talents belong to God and through the Holy Spirit are disposed of according to His will and providence. What is needed from each of us is the willingness to be moved by the promptings of the Spirit in our daily lives. Relationship with our Blessed Mother is always profitable precisely because She is best equipped to teach us how to be open to the Holy Spirit. We know of the many attributes of Our Lord that compelled Our Lord to make His dwelling among us in Her. The virtue most appropriate for pliability in the hands of the Holy Spirit is the virtue of humility. To be humble before God requires awareness, not only of our weaknesses but also our strengths and talents. To truly allow God to mold and use me and to become a vessel for the Holy Spirit I must recognize the goodness of God within even as I entreat the Lord to take away my sins and weaknesses. Let us make the publican of Luke’s Gospel our model and pray with simplicity as he did: O God, be merciful to me a sinner.

In addition to our celebration of Holy Mass, there will be a Marian Procession and the public recitation of the Most Holy Rosary. CELEBRATION OF ST. LOUIS, KING OF FRANCE

The Feast of St. Louis, King of France is celebrated on 25 August which is a Tuesday this year. Given that he is the patron of the Archdiocese along with the desire on the part of some members of the community to discredit and dishonor him, this year we will give even more attention to our celebration of this great saint of Holy Mother Church.

On Monday, 24 August 2020 beginning at 4:30 pm we will have Eucharistic Adoration; at 5:15 pm we will celebrate Sung Vespers; at 6:00 pm we will conclude with Benediction. This schedule allows those who want to make their way to the Statue of St. Louis in Forest Park for the Rosary at 6:30 pm.

On Tuesday, 25 August 2020, we will have our normal 7:00 am Holy Mass; in addition, we will celebrate High Mass at 12:15; the day will conclude with Adoration at 4 pm until 5 pm Benediction and then a procession from the Oratory to the Statue of St. Louis in Forest Park (approx. 1.9 mi.) for the rosary at 6:30 pm.
