



Third Sunday of Lent

FROM THE RECTOR - Third Sunday of Lent

Christ conquers Satan! That declarative statement should be the only motivation needed to continue our fidelity to prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. We have undertaken our Lenten disciplines in order to make ourselves empty that Christ might fill us up. We are aware of our sinfulness, maybe all too well, and feel powerless to overcome our faults and failings. This is what Satan wants us to believe, that we are not strong enough to overcome sin and put on the new man who is Christ. Our Gospel from Saint Luke detailing the Lord's victory over Satan reminds us what the truth actually is: Christ is always the Victor over sin and death. This must translate into a firm conviction that I too can share in this victory if I am remain faithful and stay with the Lord. That I am sinner is true; that Christ is the conqueror of sin is also true. Prepare yourself for sharing in His victory by joyfully making sacrifice. Remain with the Lord by dying to sin and allowing Christ to give you new life!

FEAST OF ST. GREGORY THE GREAT

Friday, 12 March 2021 is the Feast of St. Gregory the Great, one of our principal patrons. In addition to the normal Friday Holy Mass, the Oratory will celebrate Solemn High Mass that evening at 7:00 pm preceded by confessions at 6:00 pm. All our encouraged to attend!

SEASON OF LENT

Confessions will be heard before the 7 am Masses on Tuesday and Thursday, beginning at 6 am.

We will also have the morning of Confessions on Saturday, 27 March 2021 from 9:00 am until 12 Noon.

Stations of Cross are celebrated each Friday of Lent immediately following the 12:15 pm Holy Mass.

The schedule for Holy Week is as follows: HOLY THURSDAY @ 4:00 PM; GOOD FRIDAY @ 3PM; HOLY SATURDAY @ 4:00 PM.

ON-GOING EDUCATION

The next series of talks planned for the Oratory will be on the nature and meaning of sacrifice in the Holy Mass. Beginning March 16th and continuing on the following two Tuesdays (March 23rd and March 30th) we will have the opportunity to more deeply explore the saving sacrifice of Christ and our participation in the triumph of His sacrifice at Holy Mass. All talks begin at 7 pm and will also be videoed for those unable to attend.

OFFICE OF TENEBRAE

"Tenebrae" is the name given to the service of Matins and Lauds belonging to the last three days of Holy Week and normatively anticipated the evening before. These services are marked by a somber and sober, nearly mournful praying of the Divine Office. The structure of the office is sparse reflecting the seriousness of these sacred days and the sadness that should accompany all of us because Christ our Savior suffered for our sins.

The Oratory of Ss. Gregory and Augustine will have the opportunity to pray Tenebrae on the following evenings:

- Wednesday, 31 March @ 9:00 pm Tenebrae of Holy • Thursday
- Thursday, 1 April @ 9:00 pm Tenebrae of Good Friday •
- Friday, 2 April @ 9:00 pm Tenebrae of Holy Saturday

This is a wonderful, solemn and profound way to enter more deeply into the Sacred Triduum and the Paschal Mystery which has brought us our salvation.
