



Feast of St. Mark the Evangelist (Third Sunday after Easter) April 25, 2021

FROM THE RECTOR - Feast of St. Mark the Evangelist (Third Sunday after Easter)

Today in the older calendar that existed prior to 1955, the Church celebrates St. Mark the Evangelist. It is known that St. Mark was a disciple of St. Paul and wrote the most active of the four gospels focusing clearly on the missionary work of our Lord. It is the shortest of the gospels because St. Mark's concern was to clear and vividly set forth the work of Christ in bringing about our salvation. The Introit for today's Holy Mass speaks about the reception of protection against "the workers of iniquity" (Introit) and the Collect reminds of our need to be receptive and vigilant so that "we may ever profit by his [St. Mark] teaching and be defended by his prayers" (Collect). The celebration of any saints calls to mind the power of grace to assist us in living rightly in the sight of God: as these holy men and women have done, so I can and should do as well ought to be our thought each time we contemplate the lives of the saints. As we celebrate today the life of St. Mark, we are mindful of this but also of the exhortation to proclaim the good news of Christ to the ends of the earth. Our baptismal dignity grafts us unto Christ and requires from us a convicted and daily witness to His Truth even to the shedding our blood. Tradition asserts that St. Mark was martyred in Alexandria with his body eventually finding its resting place in the city of Venice in the grand cathedral dedicated to him. Let us pray today through his intercession for a willingness to sacrifice our own lives in order to boldly proclaim the Gospel message of Jesus Christ!
