FROM THE RECTOR – Fifth Sunday after Pentecost

The Lessons for the celebration of the Fifth Sunday after Pentecost remind us of the importance of the virtue of Christian charity which assists in living in harmony with our brothers and sisters in Christ. When we are faithful to keeping the commandments of God, we are truly keeping the greatest commandment: to love one another as we have been loved. This love of our neighbor comes from our shared dignity as beloved children of the Father. This shared dignity, enflamed by the love of God, has always animated Christian charity. Our service to our neighbors is not for good social order nor to draw attention to ourselves nor to curry favor with others that they might someday take care of us. We share the love given to us with others; it is that pure and that simple. Moreover, charity involves a willingness to forgive, to show mercy even when it’s not requested and to give mercy freely when others beg it from us. Neither of these demands of charity are easily accomplished unless we strive daily for intimate union with Our Lord and always remain open to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. Let us then be mindful in this coming week of the many opportunities to love others as we have been loved through our generous service to our neighbors and our joyful forgiveness and patience with the faults of others.
