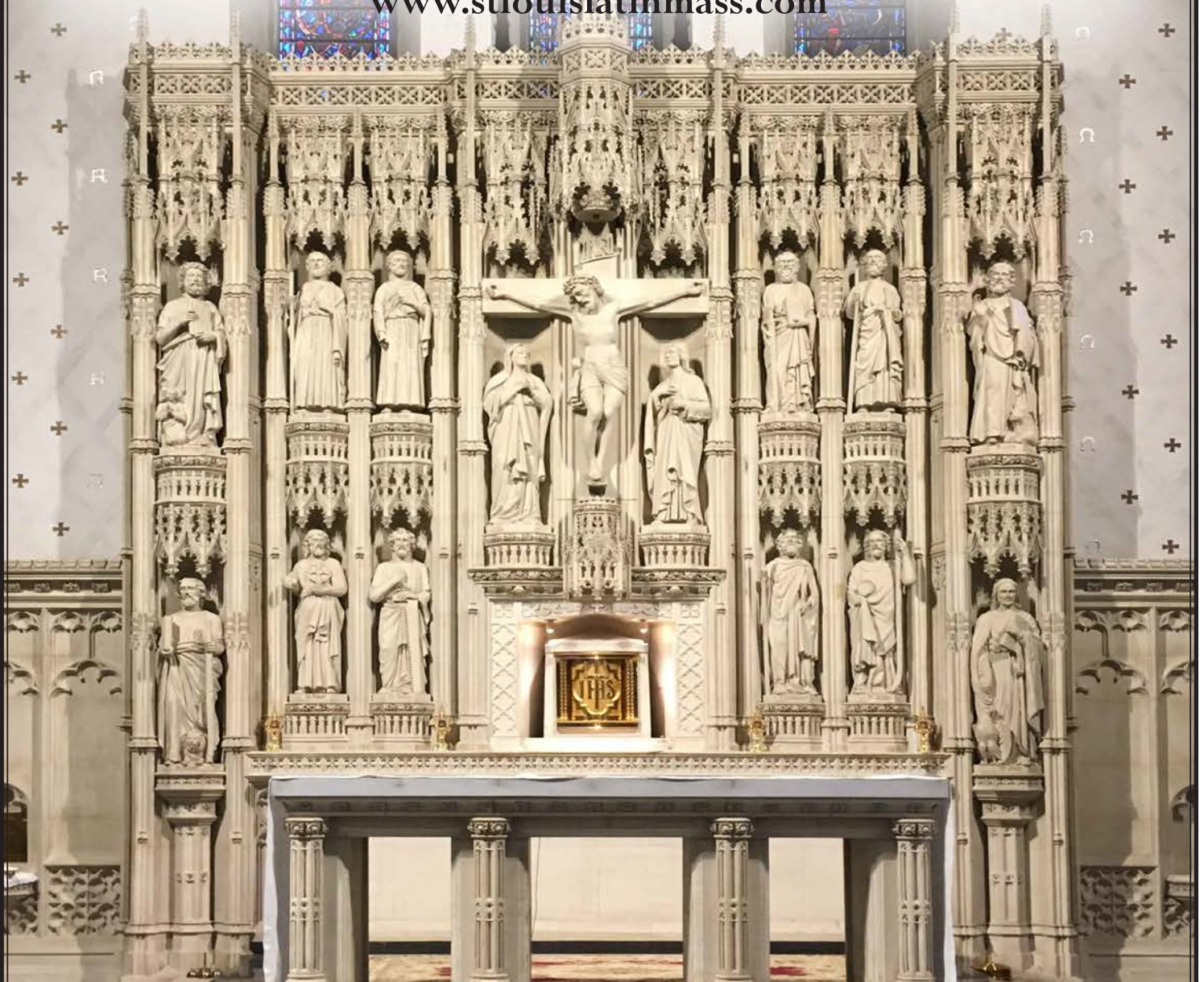

FROM THE RECTOR – 13th Sunday after Pentecost

However, more often than not, we behave like the nine lepers, rejoicing in God’s blessings but failing to give Him praise and thanksgiving. Today, as we yet again approach the altar of sacrifice, let us strive to first rely completely upon the Lord and then recognizing His blessings, let us always return and give Him thanks.

ORATORY TITHING

As we begin a new fiscal year, I want to express my gratitude to the members of the Oratory’s Finance committee, especially the chairman Todd Grizzle, for their assistance in using well the generous donations of the Oratory. So too, I want to express my gratitude to each member of the Oratory for your generosity to the Oratory that has allowed us to continue to grow.
