#### FROM THE RECTOR - 14th Sunday after Pentecost

We must always trust in the Lord. These words are simple in proclamation, but profound in execution. We understand on an intellectual level the call contained in Sacred Scripture this Sunday to place our trust in the Lord in all things. Our Savior enjoins us to put aside anxiety and worry over the cares and concerns of the world. Of course, this exhortation does not mean we are indifferent to a diligence in worldly matters. We need to feed, clothe and house ourselves and those entrusted to us. However, we also must guard against allowing these pursuits to overshadow our confidence in the Lord especially when we struggle to meet our needs and to care for ourselves and others. When we are confronted with difficulty and encounter resistance to legitimate efforts to care for our needs our response should be to turn to the Lord and rely upon Him. Moreover, these struggles provide a wonderful opportunity to suffer with Christ so as to live His new life. This trust in the Lord is not an easy task to live and the world in which we live with its emphasis on material possessions makes it even harder to trust in the Lord. However, as we celebrate the triumph and the glory of the Lord's Cross, we accept joyfully the sacrifices of this world which bring us closer to our Lord in the world to come.
