FROM THE RECTOR - 15th Sunday after Pentecost

It is hard to comprehend the depth of Christ's compassion, love and mercy. In our Gospel for the Fifteenth Sunday after Pentecost, the Lord restores the deceased son of the widow of Nain to his grieving mother. He brings one who was dead back to life out of compassion for the mother who was bereft and lost without her son. As the Lord restores the young man of Nain, so He restores each of us after we have died in our sins bringing us back to life and returning us to our Mother the Church. His love for us should stir up in us a constant trust and a fervent hope in His power over sin and death and the darkness of the world.

The trust we have in the Lord, who is able to conquer sin and death, translates into profound hope in our daily lives. Concretely, the current uncertainty created by the recent motu proprio *Traditionis Custodes* should not lead us to despair. Archbishop Rozanski granted my request to continue to celebrate the Traditional Latin Mass and remain as the rector of the Oratory of Ss. Gregory and Augustine. He also indicated that the Archdiocese would continue to study the concrete implications of this motu propria seeking fidelity to the Pope but also recognizing and appreciating how many faithful are dedicated to the traditional sacraments. Practically speaking, our future is secure for now, but there still might be changes to come. We could choose to see this situation as living in limbo, waiting for the bottom to fall out, or we can trust in the Lord who will provide for us. The provisions God gives to us require the cross, necessitate sacrifice, and demand humility before His divine providence. Now, more than ever, we must strive for confidence in the Lord. So too, we must work diligently to build unity and peace in Christ and overcome any divisions among us. Our home, our peace, and our joy are in God and Him alone. Let us joyfully place our lives into His hands.
