FROM THE RECTOR - 16th Sunday after Pentecost

Confidence in God's Divine Providence is difficult to foster and develop in our daily lives. We naturally tend to rely upon our own devices and strength trusting in what we know and see before us. Our Father enjoins us to abandon ourselves to Him and sends His Son so that we might know the Father and see the love of the Father in the flesh. Therein lies the difficulty for us: if God had not shown Himself to be worthy of our trust, if there were no clear manifestations of His power and strength, then we could persist in self-reliance. However, we have the Incarnate Word and the Victorious Cross, both compelling trust and confidence in God's design for the world. Why do we continue to trust ourselves when doing so bears no fruit? While there are a number of answers to the question, the simplest is the sin of pride, the dangers of hubris. Pride truly is the root of all that is evil for the prideful man has no need of God. Sadly, history and our own lived experiences make clear that life without God is chaos. The only way to true peace, lasting joy, and stability and surety is trusting in God and giving ourselves over to Him. This is best achieved through diligently living out the virtue of humility. The humble man knows of the radical dependence that we must have on God and finds comfort in this relationship. During this week it would serve us well to repeat the words of St. John the Baptist: He must increase; I must decrease!
