FROM THE RECTOR - 1st Sunday of Advent

The season of Advent provides us with the opportunity to contemplate the glories of the Incarnation. The celebration of the birth of Our Lord in history is met with profound joy as we also prepare ourselves to meet Our Lord in His glory at the end of time. Christ has come, Christ is coming, and Christ is with us now. For us, these three realities are separated by time and space but because of His great generosity they are bound together and alive in the mystery of the Most Holy Eucharist. Through the Living God we have contact with His mercy and rightly receive from Him justice and judgement. These days of Advent exhort us to a renewed sense of sorrow and reparation for our sins, a deepened awareness of the Lord's mercy and an intensified expectation of the glories to come. While the penitential character of Advent is less intense than that of Lent, it is still important to make sacrifice, deny ourselves and to take up our Cross and follow Him. Soon comes our Lord and King; Hasten to adore Him!

NO PUBLIC MASSES: 29 November thru 2 December

Monday, 29 November through Thursday, 2 December there will be <u>NO</u> Public Masses or Confessions. Public sacraments will resume on 3 December which is First Friday. Also, a reminder that Eucharistic Adoration is suspended and that there will **NO** Adoration on First Friday.

The Oratory will join St. Luke the Evangelist for the Giving Tree this year during the Advent Season. The GIVING TREE will be up next weekend! Again, this year support will be given to the Saint Vincent DePaul clients of Saint Luke the Evangelist and families that are served by Birthright.

SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION

The Immaculate Conception will be celebrated this year on Wednesday, 8 December 2021. In addition to the normal evening Holy Mass at 6:30 pm, there will also be a <u>Holy Mass celebrated at 12:15 pm that day</u>. So too, in addition to confessions at 5:00 pm, they will also be available at 11:00 am. There will be **NO** Adoration on this day.

CONFESSIONS: 11 DECEMBER from 8:00 to 11:00 am.

The faithful of both the Oratory and St. Luke will have the opportunity for an extended period of confessions on Saturday morning, 11 December 2021 from 8 am until 11 am. Both Msgr. Morris and Fr. Blake will be available for confession during that time. If you have had difficulty getting to confession, this may serve as the perfect opportunity to take advantage of the tribunal of mercy especially in preparation for Christmas.

CHURCH DECORATING: 18 December @ 10:00 am

On Saturday morning, December 18th at 10:00 am, the Church will be decorated for Christmas. This is the normal day for Church cleaning and more hands will be needed to assist the faithful of St. Luke with decorating the Church. If you are able to do so, please come and help both decorate the Church and then clean afterwards if necessary. In advance, thank you for your charity and generosity.

CHRISTMAS CELELBRATION (Plan early)

For the celebration of the Lord's Birth on Christmas Day, the Oratory will have the opportunity to celebrate three Sung Masses. The principal Holy Mass will be at Midnight. This will be High Mass assisted by our choir. On Christmas morning, Holy Mass will be celebrated at 6:00 am and 7:30 am. More information will be coming about Christmas and the Octave of Christmas.

THE RORATE CAELI MASS:

When: 11 December 2021 @ 6:30 am

The Rorate Caeli Mass is a traditional Advent devotion wherein the Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary for Advent is offered just before dawn.

The Mass takes its title, Rorate Caeli, from the first words of the Introit, which are from Isaiah 45:8:

"Rorate, caeli, desuper, et nubes pluant justum, aperiatur terra, et germinet Salvatorem."

"Drop down dew, ye heavens, from above, and let the clouds rain the just: let the earth be opened and bud forth a Saviour."

The Rorate Mass is lit only by candlelight. Because it is a votive Mass in Mary's honor, white vestments are worn instead of Advent violet. In the dimly lit setting, priests and faithful prepare to honor the Light of the world, Who is soon to be born, and offer praise to God for the gift of Our Lady. As the Mass proceeds and sunrise approaches, the church becomes progressively brighter, illumined by the sun as our Faith is illumined by Christ.

The readings and prayers of the Mass foretell the prophecy of the Virgin who would bear a Son called Emmanuel and call on all to raise the gates of their hearts and their societies to let Christ the King enter; asking for the grace to receive eternal life by the merits of the Incarnation and saving Resurrection of Our Lord.
