The Vigil Mass for The Epiphany of Our Lord will be celebrated on Wednesday, 5 January 2022. At the conclusion of Holy Mass, water and salt will be blessed as is our tradition here at the Oratory. In order to better facilitate the blessing of Epiphany water, no outside containers will be allowed this year. Enough water and salt will be blessed and made available to the faithful after Holy Mass and for as long as the water remains. For the Feast of the Epiphany in addition to the normal 7 am Holy Mass, we will also celebrate High Mass at 12:15 pm with confessions heard at 11 am.
