FROM THE RECTOR – Septuagesima

Today we celebrate Septuagesima Sunday and benefit from the wisdom of Holy Mother Church as She assists us preparing ourselves for our Lenten Retreat. How blessed we are to have these weeks to prepare ourselves for this journey that requires spiritual strength and constancy. One does not prepare for a marathon the day before it begins. THE LENTEN SEASON

The season of Septuagesima begins on Sunday, 13 February 2022 and provides us with the opportunity to better prepare ourselves for our Lenten Season which begins on Ash Wednesday, 2 March 2022. In order to spiritually assist the faithful of the Oratory during the Lenten season there will be additional opportunities for both confession and the celebration of the Holy Mass.

During Lent, in addition to the times already published, <u>Confessions</u> will be heard from 11:30 am until 12:45 pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays (beginning 8 March 2022).

We will also have the opportunity for <u>Eucharistic Adoration</u> on the following days and times (beginning Friday, 4 April 2022):

- Wednesday: 5:00 pm to 6:15 pm
- Tuesday/Thursday: 11:00 am until 1:00 pm
- First Friday: 1:00 pm until 6:00 pm

Stations of the Cross will be celebrated on the Fridays of Lent after the conclusion of the 12:15 pm Holy Mass with the exception of the First Friday in March (4 March) and April (1 April).

Finally, the schedule for <u>Holy Week</u> has been determined and will allow us to celebrate the full Sacred Triduum this year. I share this information with you this early so that you might plan your schedules accordingly: HOLY THURSDAY @ 4:00 PM; GOOD FRIDAY @ 3:00 PM; HOLY SATURDAY @ 2:00 PM

All of this information will continue to be available both in our bulletin and on-line. Also, next Sunday there will be a sheet on the Oratory table in the vestibule that will have all this information for our Lenten season.

LENTEN DAYS OF RECOLLECTION

In order to assist the faithful during the Lenten season, there will be a Day of Recollection for both the women and men of the Oratory of Ss. Gregory and Augustine. The day begins with Holy Mass at 8:15 am and concludes by 2 pm. The retreat is open to non-parishioners and everyone is encouraged to attend.
