FROM THE RECTOR – Quinquagesima Sunday

Love and sacrifice are beautifully wedded to each other when Christ mounts the Cross. Throughout His public ministry, the Son endeavored by word and deed to make manifest the Father's love for His chosen people. God offered Himself time and again and was rejected time and again through the sinfulness of the people and their refusal to be obedient to the covenant. The Father never abandoned us because of the love He bears us and in the fullness of time the gift of His Son is the definitive manifestation of that love He has towards us. For His part, the Son is obedient to the work and will of His Father including the gift of His broken body and the shedding of His precious blood. Like His Father, it is love that moves the Son to embrace the cross. As it is for Christ, so it must be for each us. With joy, confidence and peace we must embrace our daily crosses and the motivation for our joyous embrace must be the love shown to us by God that we desire to return. Simply put: if we accept God's love and return that love to Him, the most concrete manifestation of this love is the Cross. What greater gift of love could you offer than to give your life as ransom for others. Embrace your daily crosses, pray for the opportunity to sacrifice and truly love others as God has loved you.

THE LENTEN SEASON

The season of Septuagesima begins on Sunday, 13 February 2022 and provides us with the opportunity to better prepare ourselves for our Lenten Season which begins on Ash Wednesday, 2 March 2022. In order to spiritually assist the faithful of the Oratory during the Lenten season there will be additional opportunities for both confession and the celebration of the Holy Mass.

During Lent, in addition to the times already published, <u>Confessions</u> will be heard from 11:15 am until 12:45 pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays (beginning Thursday, 3 March 2022).

We will also have the opportunity for <u>Eucharistic Adoration</u> on the following days and times (beginning Thursday, 3 March 2022):
