FROM THE RECTOR - Second Sunday of Lent

Each Sunday of the Lenten season provides for our contemplation an aspect of the spiritual life that will lead us closer to our Lord's Cross. Last Sunday we confronted the reality of temptation, the importance of grace in overcoming temptation and the example of Christ's radical dependence on the Father for strength in battling temptations. The Second Sunday of Lent sets before our eyes the glory of the Lord's Transfiguration. Not only does this great event provide the apostles with Him further evidence of who He is and what He has come to accomplish, but also reminds us why we strive to overcome temptation and embrace our Lenten disciplines. The Lord is glorified in their midst and even though the disciples do not fully understand to what they are witnesses, we know that the glory of the Son made manifest is ours to share in if we remain faithful and steadfast. The sonship testified to by the Father is the impetus for our striving for holiness: we too are adopted children by the blood of the Cross and the waters of baptism. In order to continuously share in this glory, we must follow our brother in His obedience, to joyfully carry our crosses. Through our Lenten disciplines, let us pray for the strength to overcome our fears and to follow the Lord wherever He may lead us!
