FROM THE RECTOR - Fourth Sunday of Lent (Laetare Sunday)

The Fourth Sunday of Lent is traditionally called Laetare Sunday taking its name from the opening words of the Introit: *Rejoice, O Jerusalem*! Our joy is exhorted not only because our Lenten pilgrimage has considerably advanced but also, and more importantly, because we are yet again reminded of the power of Christ's salvific work on the Cross. The Church teaches us through the sacred liturgy and the Divine Office of the work of our Heavenly Father with His Chosen people setting them free from slavery in Egypt and then feeding them with manna, giving them the Law on Mount Sinai on their sojourn to the Promised Land. Moses is God's prophet, but in Christ we have Moses fulfilled. And the work of Christ frees us from the slavery to sin, feeds us with His own Body and delivers us to the new Jerusalem in Heaven. These are all reasons to rejoice and give thanks to God. Continue your Lenten journey with diligence and joy. Now more than ever do not waver or stumble carrying your cross. Life's difficulties provide ample opportunities for us to configure ourselves to Christ crucified. And for that opportunity and the blessings bestowed upon us, let us rejoice in the Lord!
