FROM THE RECTOR - Tenth Sunday after Pentecost

When the Oratory began celebrating the 6:45 am Holy Mass in May of 2000, it was in response to the Covid mandates for social distancing. At that time, the Oratory was blessed with the generosity of priests who were willing and able to make a stable commitment in offering Holy Mass each Sunday. In the intervening two years the availability of those particular priests coupled with the implications of the recent motu proprio, maintaining three Holy Masses on Sunday is no longer viable. As such, beginning Sunday, 4 September 2022, the Oratory will return to its original schedule of Sunday Masses at 8:00 am (Low Mass) and 11:30 am (Solemn/Sung Mass). My apologies for those who have regularly assisted at the 6:45 am Holy Mass. Hopefully, this change will present only a minor inconvenience. It is also a hope that those who have assisted at 6:45 am will have the opportunity to come to know those who regularly attend the 8:00 am and 11:30 am Holy Masses. GUILD OF SAINT STEPHEN

This past Sunday, before the celebration of the 11:30 am Holy Mass, the young men and men listed below were inducted into the St. Stephen Guild for altar servers. The Guild of St. Stephen was established in 1905 by permission of the Archbishop of Westminster for altar boys in the English-speaking world. Every time a member says the *Prayers at the Foot of the Altar*, he promises to share those graces with all the other souls of the Guild who are in need and receives the benefits from those prayers through the Communion of Saints when he is in need.

The Guild for the Oratory of Ss. Gregory and Augustine was established at the Oratory under Fr. Bede Price, 1st Rector, and is affiliated with the Archconfraternity in Westminster. It has been several years since a new cadre of altar servers has been enrolled here at the Oratory and the boys/men have been involved in intense practices and preparations for their induction.

During the ceremony of induction, each server received a medal that he wears when he serves at Holy Mass. The Medal is emblazoned with the motto: *Cui servire, regnare est* – To serve Him is to reign. It is decorated with the palm and red tassels for martyrdom, a crown indicating the life of St. Stephen.
