FROM THE RECTOR – Thirteenth Sunday after Pentecost

The capacity of the human person to be self-directed and willful is overwhelming. We might want to believe in our ability to give ourselves completely over to God; however, the reality and proliferation of sin make very clear the capacity of the human person for continued willfulness and confidence in his own abilities. As Catholics, one of the hallmarks of our growth in the spiritual life is a distrust of self, placing our complete confidence and trust in the Lord and His power to care for us and to save us. The more we allow grace to mold us into trustful creatures the more we also grow in the virtue of gratitude. Like the lepers in our Gospel today, we approach the Lord and beg for His mercy and the healing that always accompanies that mercy. Of course, the Lord cares for our bodies and physical well-being according to His Divine Providence. He also cares for our souls and provides us immediate remedy to the devasting impact of our sins. However, more often than not, we behave like the nine lepers, rejoicing in God's blessings but failing to give Him praise and thanksgiving. Today, as we yet again approach the altar of sacrifice, let us strive to first rely completely upon the Lord and then recognizing His blessings, let us always return to Him and give Him thanks.
