The Divine Office is a significant part of the patrimony of Holy Mother Church. The sanctification of the hours throughout the day serves to assist all of us with keeping our eyes on the Lord. In order to better integrate the Divine Office into the life of the Oratory of Ss. Gregory & Augustine, we are currently chanting the hour of Terce before the 11:30 am Sunday Mass and then each Sunday evening chanting Vespers at 4:30 pm.

Beginning the First Sunday of Advent (27 November 2022), the hour of Prime will be chanted at the conclusion of the 6:30 am Holy Mass and the night hour of Compline will be chanted on Wednesday evenings after the 6:30 pm Holy Mass. Please take advantage of these great spiritual opportunities and encourage others to do so.

#### THE RORATE CAELI MASS

#### When: 10 December 2022 @ 6:30 am

The Rorate Caeli Mass is a traditional Advent devotion wherein the Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary for Advent is offered just before dawn.

The Mass takes its title, Rorate Caeli, from the first words of the Introit, which are from Isaiah 45:8:

"Rorate, caeli, desuper, et nubes pluant justum, aperiatur terra, et germinet Salvatorem." ("Drop down dew, ye heavens, from above, and let the clouds rain the just: let the earth be opened and bud forth a Saviour.")

The Rorate Mass is lit only by candlelight. Because it is a votive Mass in Mary's honor, white vestments are worn instead of Advent violet. In the dimly lit setting, priests and faithful prepare to honor the Light of the world, Who is soon to be born, and offer praise to God for the gift of Our Lady. As the Mass proceeds and sunrise approaches, the church becomes progressively brighter, illumined by the sun as our Faith is illumined by Christ. The readings and prayers of the Mass foretell the prophecy of the Virgin who would bear a Son called Emmanuel and call on all to raise the gates of their hearts and their societies to let Christ the King enter; asking for the grace to receive eternal life by the merits of the Incarnation and saving Resurrection of Our Lord.
