THE "O" ANTIPHONS

The Roman Catholic Church has been singing the "O" Antiphons since at least the eighth century. They are the antiphons that accompany the *Magnificat* canticle of Vespers from December 17-23. They are a magnificent theology that uses ancient biblical imagery drawn from the messianic hopes of the Old Testament to proclaim the coming Christ as the fulfillment not only of Old Testament hopes, but present ones as well.

The Oratory of Ss. Gregory & Augustine will be praying public vespers for these greater days of Advent and chanting the O Antiphons. The schedule is as follows:

EPIPHANY 2023

The Vigil Mass for The Epiphany of Our Lord will be celebrated on Thursday, 5 January 2023. There will be two Holy Masses for the Vigil: the normally scheduled Low Mass @ 7:00 am and a Holy Mass celebrated at 12:15 pm preceded by confessions @ 11:00 am. At the conclusion of the 12:15 pm Holy Mass, water and salt will be blessed as is our tradition. As we did last year, to better facilitate the blessing of Epiphany water, no outside containers will be allowed. Enough water and salt will be blessed and made available to the faithful after Holy Mass and for as long as the water remains. The Feast of the Epiphany (6 January 2023) will follow the normal first Friday schedule: Holy Masses @ 12:15 pm and 7:15 pm; confessions @ 11:00 am and 6:00 pm.
