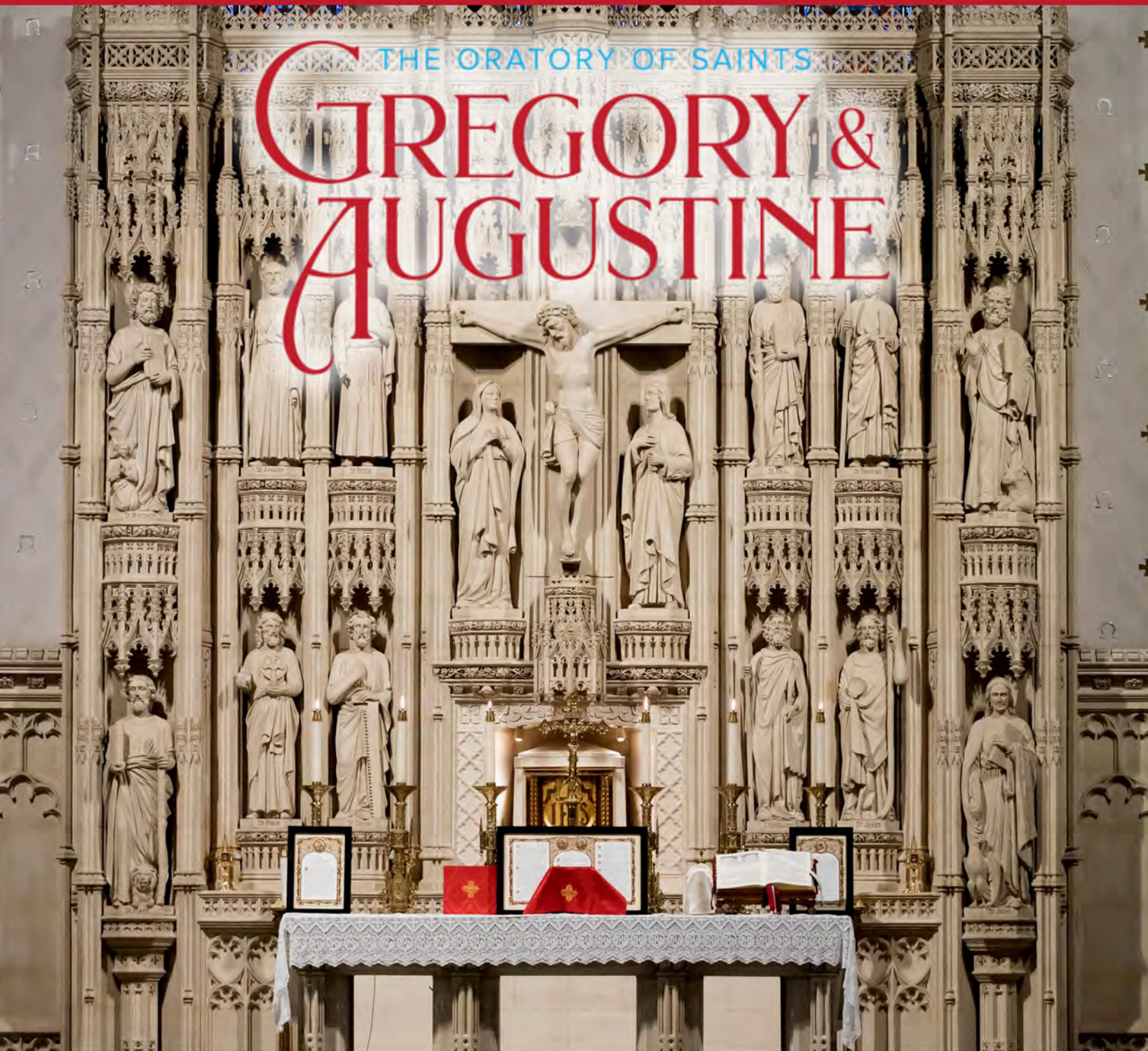

There will be NO Public Confessions or Holy Mass on Monday, 2 January 2023. So too, the Oratory office will be closed that day. The normal schedule resumes on Tuesday, 3 January 2023.

**EPIPHANY 2023**

The Vigil Mass for The Epiphany of Our Lord will be celebrated on Thursday, 5 January 2023. There will be two Holy Masses for the Vigil: the normally scheduled Low Mass @ 7:00 am and a Holy Mass celebrated at 12:15 pm preceded by confessions @ 11:00 am. At the conclusion of the 12:15 pm Holy Mass, water and salt will be blessed as is our tradition. As we did last year, to better facilitate the blessing of Epiphany water, no outside containers will be allowed. Enough water and salt will be blessed and made available to the faithful after Holy Mass and for as long as the water remains. The Feast of the Epiphany (6 January 2023) will follow the normal first Friday schedule: Holy Masses @ 12:15 pm and 7:15 pm; confessions @ 11:00 am and 6:00 pm. Eucharistic Adoration from 1:00 pm until 6:00 pm.

**FROM THE RECTOR**

There are three realities celebrated today in the sacred liturgy. The first is the Octave Day of Christmas. The nature of the mystery of the incarnation is such that it requires eight days of contemplation and rejoicing. In truth, the texts of Holy Mass reflect that the primary focus is on the mystery of the Incarnation. The second focus of Holy Mass is Our Blessed Mother. It is fitting that on this Octave Day we would honor this most worthy tabernacle for the Word Made Flesh. Contemplation of the Incarnation is more fruitful through the mediation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The third focus for today provides the name for this feast, the circumcision of Our Lord according to the Mosaic law. The act of circumcision was seen by the early Church as a type of baptism, a physical manifestation of the spiritual reality of baptism through which we are marked as children of God. It is a feast day like today that reminds us of the richness of the Church's tradition and Her wisdom in trusting Her beloved children to rejoice in these varied ways. As we continue to give thanks to the Father for His Incarnate Son, let us entreat Our Lady to assist us in growing in holiness, striving for purity of body and spirit, and seeking for an ever-deeper intimacy with Christ Our Savior!
