The season of Septuagesima begins next Sunday, 17 February 2019 and provides us with the opportunity to better prepare ourselves for our Lenten Season which begins on Wednesday, 6 March 2019. In order to spiritually assist the faithful of the Oratory during the Lenten season there will be additional opportunities for both confession and the celebration of the Holy Mass.
