## THE LENTEN SEASON

The season of Septuagesima begins next Sunday, 17 February 2019 and provides us with the opportunity to better prepare ourselves for our Lenten Season which begins on Wednesday, 6 March 2019. In order to spiritually assist the faithful of the Oratory during the Lenten season there will be additional opportunities for both confession and the celebration of the Holy Mass.

During Lent, in addition to the times already published, confessions will be heard before the 7 am Masses on Tuesday and Thursday, beginning at 6 am. Also, confessions will be heard from 11:00 am until 11:45 am on the Fridays of Lent.

In addition to our normal Mass schedule, there will be a 12 noon Mass on the Fridays of Lent. This will include the First Friday of April when there will be two Masses, the normal 7:00 pm evening Mass and the 12 noon Mass.

Finally, the schedule for Holy Week has been determined and will allow us to celebrate the full Sacred Triduum this year. I share this information with you this early so that you might plan your schedules accordingly: **HOLY THURSDAY @ 5:00 PM; GOOD FRIDAY @ 3PM; HOLY SATURDAY @ 5:00 PM**

All of this information will continue to be available both in our bulletin and on-line. Also, next Sunday there will be a sheet on the Oratory table in the vestibule that will have all this information for our Lenten season.

In order to assist the faithful during the Lenten season, there will be a Day of Recollection for both the women and men of the Oratory of Ss. Gregory and Augustine.
