Information about the music being used during the Advent season:

- The hymns for processional and recessional will come from the books available in the pews and the numbers will be on the hymn board at the front of the Church on the right side as you face the sanctuary.

READNG THE GOSPEL IN ENGLISH

On this First Sunday of Advent, we will inaugurate a new practice for the celebration of the Holy Mass: **the Gospel will be read in English before the Homily**. The faithful are asked to remain standing as the priest approaches the pulpit, stay standing for the Gospel which will be read without any introduction and conclude without any response. After the Gospel is read in English, the faithful may be seated.
